Swap-A-Book Day

Friday 7th July

This involves students bringing in books from home that they no longer require, and swapping them. This swap is permanent; the students keep the books they choose.

The criteria for the books are:

- o Books are gently used
- o Books are appropriate for our students
- o No colouring or sticker books

Students bring their books in during the two weeks before the day (from 26th June) and give them to their teacher. The teacher will then give them a ticket and write on it how many books they have brought in. On Swap-a-Book day the students exchange these tickets for books. Students should bring a plastic bag to put their books in.

Swap-a-Book day will be held on Friday 7th July in the school hall. Teachers will bring their class through, and we will be open after school until 3.30pm.

Any child who has not been able to bring a book in will have the opportunity to choose from the remaining books when we have 'free for all' hour from 2.30-3.30 pm. During this hour everybody is encouraged to come in and take as many books as they want. This includes parents and siblings, as well as students who have already selected their books.
